## June's Programs



### Stop The Bleed

No matter how rapid the arrival of professional emergency responders, bystanders will always be first on the scene. A person who is bleeding can die from blood loss within five minutes, so it's important to **STOP THE BLEED** as soon as possible.

Remember to be aware of your surroundings and move yourself and the injured person to safety, if necessary.

#### Call 911.

Bystanders can take simple steps to keep the injured alive until appropriate medical care is available. Here are three actions that you can take to help save a life:

- 1. Apply Pressure with Hands**  
ELEVATE to the extent the bleeding is coming from an arm or leg. **APPLY PRESSURE** to the bleeding site with both hands if possible.
- 2. Apply Dressing and Press**  
ELEVATE to the extent the bleeding is coming from an arm or leg. **APPLY PRESSURE** to the bleeding site with bandage or cloth.
- 3. Apply Tourniquet(s)**
