SEED LENDING LIBRARY

The seed swap cabinet has arrived—thanks to the Deer-Mt. Judea School District! We will be collecting seeds this fall—focusing on heirloom—for distribution in the spring. All seeds you want to donate must grow well in our region. Please package them in an envelope and label for growing: what type of plant? super easy, easy, or hard to grow? Etc. We are looking for vegetables, herbs, and flowers. All seeds can be dropped off during regular business hours at the Library. Please help us bring the joy of gardening to everyone in our community. Seeds will be dispersed in small quantity packets (approx. 6—dependent on size) for each checkout. In the spirit of the program, you are expected to return at least the same amount at the end of the growing season.
